

Your visit to the LSEC

The Laupāhoehoe facilities are located at ~ 1500 feet in the town of Laupāhoehoe. Average annual rainfall is 135 inches with an average coastal temperature range of 74°F. Please note the elevation in consideration of your clothing needs. It can be hot and sunny or wet and cold.

What to expect:

- Center is off grid; tenants are expected to conserve both water and electricity
 - Water catchment system with potable water and UV filtration system
 - Solar electricity with back-up generator
- Single size beds; linens provided (fitted and flat sheet and pillowcase); pillow, blanket, and towel also provided
- Communal kitchen with propane range and oven; stocked with dinnerware, pots, pans, etc.
- Kitchen also includes: refrigerator/freezer, dishwasher, coffee maker, microwave
- Self-serve laundry with washing machine and dryer (must supply your own detergent)
- Flushing toilets, sinks and showers; hot and cold running water
- Wireless internet service (which may go down from time to time)
- Self-service janitorial supplies provided; tenants expected to clean as needed and keep common spaces tidy at all times
- Building includes a classroom/meeting area and there may be large groups present during your stay day or night
- Dehumidifiers are in use to keep the moisture levels down and prevent mold
- HEPA filters are available for use as needed

Restrictions:

- Quiet hours from 10pm-6am
- Maximum classroom capacity is 36 people
- No pets allowed
- Guest Policy -
 - Day guests allowed only if reported in advance to HETF Project Manager
 - Overnight guests not permitted
- No firearms or deadly weapons allowed
- Alcoholic beverages may be used only by individuals of legal drinking age
- Smoking is not permitted in or within 100 feet of Center facilities

What to bring:

- Food for your stay including any spices and condiments – these are not stocked
- Personal toiletries
- Laundry detergent
- Flashlight and batteries
- Appropriate clothing considering elevation and rainfall
- Raingear and/or umbrella
- Alarm Clock
- Bug repellent
- Indoor and/or shower shoes (outdoor footwear should not be worn indoors)
